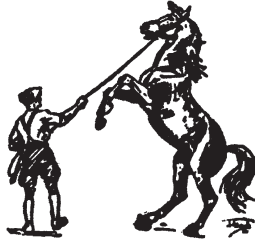

GENERAL CONDITIONS AND REGULATIONS

The show is run in accordance with SHB(GB) 2020 Rules except Horse of the Year Show classes, which are run under BSHA/Horse of the Year Show rules. In all HOYS classes, Horse of the Year Show rules take precedence, a copy of which can be downloaded from www.hoys.co.uk. Horses must be registered with the BSHA and all Owners, Exhibitors and Riders must be Association Members. Riders must be 15 years of age or older. **Registration numbers must be quoted on entry form.**

Classes 6 – 10, 18 & 19 are qualifiers for **Horse of the Year Show**, NEC, Birmingham, 7th – 11th October 2020. In classes 6-10 no horse lower than fifth will qualify. The Championship of classes 18 & 19, no horse lower than third will qualify. Qualification will be verified by the Horse of the Year Show Office.

Horses competing at the Horse of the Year Show and qualifying shows in The Hunter sections of The Sport Horse Breeding of Great Britain classes at their Affiliated Shows cannot compete in Hack, Cobs and Riding Horse classes at the same show, on the same day and vice versa. This does not apply to SHB (GB) Ridden Sport Horse classes. Entries in these classes may not compete in the Small Show Hunter of the Year and vice versa.

MEMBERSHIP

Owners and riders of horses in all ridden classes must be full members of SHB(GB), with the exception of the Ridden Irish Draught Class, unless competing on a day ticket and Horse of the Year Show classes. Exhibitors in In Hand classes do not have to be members.

SAFETY/INSURANCE

The Organisers of this Show have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organisers and all the Officials and Stewards.

OBJECTIONS

Objections of any kind must be made in writing, and delivered to the Secretary, within one hour of the close of the judging of the class concerned, accompanied by a deposit of Two Hundred & Fifty Pounds, which deposit will be forfeited if the objection should prove to be frivolous. The Objector must also state the particular and precise character of his objection. All objections will be referred to the Council, whose decision will be final.

PRIZES

In unsponsored ridden classes, prize money may be reduced on the following sliding scale:
3 entries - money to 1st Place only; 5 entries - money to 2nd Place only; 6 entries - money to 3rd Place only; 9 entries - money to 4th Place.

BROOD MARE PREMIUMS

Brood Mare Premiums will be awarded in classes 11, 20, 22, 24, 41, 48 & 50. Premiums will only be awarded if there are a minimum of three mares forward. The premium takes the form of a rosette and Service Voucher to the value of £100, awarded at the Judge's discretion to their selection from the monetary prize winners, to be used in either of the two years following the year of that award. The owner must be, or become, a fully paid up member of the SHB(GB) in order to be eligible for the award. No mare shall take more than one award per year.

PROGENY OF GRADED MARES

In classes 21, 23, 25, 26 - 34 incl, 42 - 45 incl, class 47 & classes 49, 51 & 52 - 57 incl, a rosette will be awarded to the highest placed exhibit out of a SHB(GB) graded mare.

CHAMPIONSHIPS

All horses eligible for championships must be forward.

ENTRIES

The Society reserves the right to amalgamate classes in the event of insufficient entries.

Every effort will be made for classes not to clash, but once a class has started a horse cannot leave the ring to compete in another class and then return to the original class.

Entry forms must be accompanied by the correct entry fees.

Entries close on 19th June 2020. Late entries (anything received in the SHB(GB) office after 19th June 2020) will be accepted but will be subject to a 50% additional charge for all classes (this does not apply to late qualifiers). Entries will not be acknowledged unless a SAE is enclosed. Numbers will be available for collection from the secretary's office at the show.

FIRST AID

A first aid fee of £6 per rider or In Hand exhibitor is payable at time of entry - see entry form.

HOSPITALITY AND CATERING

The Café in the indoor school will be open for supper on Tuesday 7th July from 6pm till 9pm for food and drinks. It will be open for breakfast, lunch and supper on show days and will close 1 hour after the last class. On Wednesday 8th July we will be having a Hog Roast / BBQ outside the Pavilion from 6pm at a small charge. There will be a cash bar. This will be open until 11pm.

In the Arena at the conclusion of the Evening Performance there will be some "Wacky Races", which will start approximately 20 minutes after the conclusion of the final Championship; all are welcome at this social evening for Members and non-Members.

ENTRIES

Entries for all classes close on Friday 19th June 2020. Late entries (anything received in the SHB(GB) office after 19th June 2020) will be accepted but will be subject to a 50% additional charge for all classes (this does not apply to late qualifiers).

All entries, except foals, must be in possession of current Influenza Vaccination Certificate and such document, which must undeniably relate to the horse in question, must accompany the animal when brought to the Show and may be examined.

All entries must be on the Society's Identity Record or Stud Book before the entry is accepted unless competing on a day ticket or in a Horse of the Year Show Qualifier - see conditions as printed on day ticket application form which is available to download from www.sporthorsegb.co.uk.

Entries in the In Hand Irish Draught classes do not have to be registered with SHB(GB) and exhibitors do not have to be members of SHB(GB), but if competing in any other classes at the show a day ticket must be purchased. Foals at foot do not have to be registered in their own right.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF ENTRIES AND ALLOCATION OF NUMBERS

Please note that receipt of entries will not be acknowledged unless a SAE is enclosed with entries. Numbers will be available for collection from the Secretary's Office at the show between 2pm & 5pm on Tuesday 7th July, between 7am & 5pm on Wednesday 8th July and between 7am & 1pm on Thursday 9th July.

THERE WILL NOT BE AN EXHIBITORS' MAILOUT PRIOR TO THE SHOW.

General Data Protection Regulation

Please note that there will be a photographer on site and photographs taken may be used on the SHB(GB) website, Facebook page and may be issued to Third Party Publications for the purpose of publicising the show, results and general PR in relation to SHB(GB). In addition class sponsors may receive pictures of awards to prize winners. If you do not want any pictures that may be taken of you/your horse utilised in this way please make the Secretary's office at the show aware.

Sport Horse Breeding (GB) Equine Influenza Vaccinations Policy

Equine Influenza and Tetanus vaccinations are a compulsory requirement for all horses competing in Sport Horse Breeding (GB) affiliated classes. Two injections for primary vaccination, not less than 21 days and not more than 92 days apart, are required before being eligible to compete. A first booster injection must be given within seven months after the second injection of primary vaccination. Subsequent booster injections must be given at intervals of not more than one year, commencing after the first booster injection. No horse should enter competitions within 7 days of an EI vaccination. Foals should commence vaccinations at 6 months old.

This Rule may be subject to change from guidance from the FEI/BEF and any changes will be notified via the Sport Horse Breeding (GB) website. The current FEI ruling is for a six monthly booster as opposed to annual; therefore it is recommended that all competitors/exhibitors/members/producers check with shows that fall under FEI regulation before entering, e.g. Windsor, Hickstead, HOYS etc.

NOTE: THE ABOVE WILL BE ENFORCED AT THE 2020 NATIONAL HUNTER SUPREME SHOW AND THE SOCIETY RESERVES THE RIGHT TO CARRY OUT PASSPORT/VACCINATION RECORD CHECKS. ANY UNVACCINATED HORSES TOGETHER WITH ANY ANIMALS THEY ARE IN TRANSIT WITH WILL BE TURNED AWAY FROM THE SHOWGROUND.

The winner will also receive The Sculpture to Wear Champagne Bucket and a bottle of Champagne and there will be 2 prizes of Sculpture to Wear Jewellery.

A further £500.00 will go to the Breeder who is a member of SHB(GB) and whose horse is the highest placed British Bred within the top five placings .

The Aim of this class is for Breeders or Producers to showcase their young horses. It will be open to 3 year old Geldings, Colts and Fillies which have the potential to be Working Hunters, Event Horses or Showjumpers.

Each entry will enter the arena individually with the leader. They will halt in front of the judge and then walk away and trot back and continue trotting down a long side. They will be marked a maximum 20 points for conformation and a maximum of 20 points for movement and athleticism. The horse will stay in the arena and let loose. It will be required to jump three small fences in a line with its producer dictating the pace. (He'll be in the centre with the lunge whip.) At the judges discretion he may raise the last fence to a maximum of 1.15 mtrs. 60 points maximum for this section. Full total of points allocated maximum 100.

The pedigree must be submitted along with the horse's Breeder and this will be announced by the commentator whilst the horse is performing. On the entry form there will be a section to say whether the horse is **FOR SALE**. If it is NOT For Sale then the section is to be left blank.

Horses entered in this class do not have to be registered/overstamped with SHB(GB). Exhibitors may enter more than one horse.

NO HIND BOOTS OR BANDAGES ALLOWED. FRONT BOOTS/OVER REACH BOOTS ARE ALLOWED IN THE JUMPING PHASE.

Handlers of horses in this class MUST wear correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats that meet one of the following current Safety Standards: All PAS015, VG1, (BS)EN1384 2017, ASTM F1163 04a onwards, SNELL E2001, SNELL E2016, AS/NZS 3838 2003 onwards.

From 2pm until 5pm on Tuesday 7th July the jumping lane will be set up and open for practice which is recommended – this will be supervised.

Open to 4 & 5 year old horses. To be shown on the flat, will not be required to jump. Snaffle bridles must be worn. Horses will not be ridden by the judge but will be required to give a short individual show of walk, trot & canter of approximately 1 minute, to be awarded marks out of a possible 20 for each pace. Lengthened strides in trot and canter must be shown. All horses are required for a conformation assessment to be awarded marks out of a possible 50. A maximum of 10 marks to be awarded for type and a maximum of 10 marks to be awarded for temperament.

The winner will receive The Sport Horse Trophy.

CLASS 14. FOUR & FIVE YEAR OLD POTENTIAL RIDDEN SPORT HORSE.

Open to 4 & 5 year old horses. Height of jumps will not exceed 2ft 9ins for four year olds and will not exceed 3ft 3ins for five year olds. Simple snaffle bridles must be worn as per rules for British Eventing Dressage. Horses will come into the ring individually and give a short ridden display of walk, trot & canter of approximately 1 minute then proceed straight into the jumping phase. Unless eliminated all horses will return without saddles for conformation assessment.

The winner will receive The Early Rising Trophy kindly presented by Mrs V Henson.

CLASS 15. NOVICE WORKING HUNTER.

Mares, Geldings or Stallions (competing stallions must have a red, white and blue ribbon displayed in their tail), four years old or over, exceeding 148cm (14.2 hh approx), not having won a total of £200, excluding championship prize money (or equivalent) in prize money in any SHB(GB) affiliated Working Hunter Class, or more than 5 B.E. points or 200 B.S. points, at home or equivalent abroad before 1st January 2020. Height of jumps will not exceed 3ft 3 inches.

CLASS 16. AMATEUR WORKING HUNTER

Mare, Gelding or Stallion (competing stallions must have a red, white and blue ribbon displayed in their tail), four years old or over to be ridden by an Amateur (see General Conditions and Regulations). This class to be judged in accordance with the rules for Working Hunter Competitions as laid down by SHB(GB). Height of jumps will not exceed 3ft 6inches.

In class 16, £100 will be awarded to the highest placed home produced horse – kindly sponsored by The Fieldmaster

CLASS 17. RESTRICTED OPEN WORKING HUNTER.

Mare, Gelding or Stallion (competing stallions must have a red, white and blue ribbon displayed in their tail), 4 years old and over, not to have won a total of £400, excluding championship prize money (or equivalent values) in prize money in any SHB(GB) affiliated Working Hunter class, or more than 25 BE points or 400 BS points, at home or equivalent abroad before 1st January 2020. Maximum height of fences 3'6" (1.07m). This class will be judged in accordance with the rules for Working Hunter Competitions as laid down by SHB(GB).

Winner to receive the Bournebrook Perpetual Challenge Trophy kindly presented by Mr R Walker.

CLASS 18. HORSE OF THE YEAR SHOW LIGHTWEIGHT WORKING HUNTER.

This competition is for Lightweight Working Hunters, mares, geldings or stallions (competing stallions must have a red, white and blue ribbon displayed in their tail) four years old or over, exceeding 148cm, capable of carrying up to 12 stone 7lbs, to be ridden. Small Hunters to be Included In this category. Failure to jump In the correct section will result In elimination. Any horse which has qualified as a Grade A Show Jumper or Advanced Event Horse as at 1st January in the current year is not eligible to compete in Working Hunter classes. Fences will not exceed 1.14m (3ft 9ins) in height; there should be a minimum of 8 fences and a maximum of 12 fences. The Course must contain a combination and should contain a water tray.

This class will be judged in two parts.

Part One (Jumping) will be judged first, without a jump-off. All clear rounds and any other horses the judges may require will go forward to the next part. A rider can ride up to two horses in the jumping phase but then must select only one horse to take forward into the ride and conformation if so required (no change of rider is allowed).

CLASS 19. HORSE OF THE YEAR SHOW HEAVYWEIGHT WORKING HUNTER.

This competition is for Heavyweight Working Hunters, mares, geldings or stallions (competing stallions must have a red, white and blue ribbon displayed in their tail) four years old or over,exceeding 158cm, capable of carrying over 12 stone 7lbs, to be ridden. Middleweight Hunters to be Included In this category. Failure to jump In the correct section will result In elimination.

Any horse which has qualified as a Grade A Show Jumper or Advanced Event Horse as at 1st January in the current year is not eligible to compete in Working Hunter classes. Fences will not exceed 1.14m (3ft 9ins) in height, there should be a minimum of 8 fences and a maximum of 12 fences. The Course must contain a combination and should contain a water tray. This class will be judged in two parts.

Part One (Jumping) will be judged first, without a jump-off. All clear rounds and any other horses the judges may require will go forward to the next part. A rider can ride up to two horses in the jumping phase but then must select only one horse to take forward into the ride and conformation if so required (no change of rider is allowed).

For classes 18 and 19 marks will be awarded in the following way:

PHASE I (60 MARKS)

A: JUMPING POINTS - 40 MARKS

B: STYLE WHILE JUMPING - 20 MARKS

PHASE II (40 MARKS)

C: CONFORMATION - 20 MARKS

D: RIDE - 20 MARKS

In the event of equality the CONFORMATION MARK from Phase II will take precedence, followed by the RIDE MARK, and then the STYLE MARK.

Both classes will be jumped over the same course and height. When judging the Championship, judges will use the marks they have already allocated as a guide. The highest placed unqualified horse within the top 3 of the Championship will qualify for Horse of the Year Show. The Championship is only open to the first and second prize winners in the lightweight and heavyweight Working Hunter classes respectively. The four horses forward in the Working Hunter Championship must all be placed as any one of the top three could be eligible for HOYS qualification.

The 1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 18 & 19 go through to a championship to be held during the Wednesday Evening Performance to determine which horse qualifies for Horse of the Year Show 2020. All Owners, Rider, Producers and Horses must be registered with the British Show Horse Association. Riders must be 15 years of age or older.

THE CHAMPIONSHIP OF CLASSES 18 & 19 IS A QUALIFYING COMPETITION FOR HORSE OF THE YEAR SHOW, NEC, BIRMINGHAM, 7th – 11th OCTOBER 2020.

FOR CLASSES 18 & 19 THERE WILL BE A CHAMPIONSHIP AND THE HIGHEST PLACED UNQUALIFIED HORSE IN THE TOP THREE WILL QUALIFY FOR HORSE OF THE YEAR SHOW 2020. QUALIFICATION WILL NOT PASS BELOW 3rd PLACE.
