

SHB(GB) Young Event Horse Grand Slam

Total £50,000 Prize Pool

❖ **£30,000 to the Breeder**

❖ **£10,000 to the owner**

❖ **£10,000 to the rider**

- The prize will be awarded to a British bred SHB(GB) passported horse that finishes in the first three of the 5 year old Championships, then subsequently in the first three of the 6 and 7 year old Championships at the British Eventing Young Horse Championships.

- Open to horses with SHB(GB) passports by a SHB(GB) graded stallion or out of a SHB(GB) graded mare. The horse must have a SHB(GB) passport before the close of entries for the 5 year old Championship class as specified in the British Eventing Omnibus. As for the existing rules for the Breeding Championships, there must be a proven sire, dam and dam's sire, and the breeding of sire and dam must be verified by DNA. Horses with an eligible parent but not on a SHB(GB) passport can have their passport over stamped by SHB(GB) The mare can be graded by SHB(GB) at any stage up to the close of entries for the 5 year old Championships.

- To be eligible the name of the breeder must be on the original passport.

- The owner is the person as registered with British Eventing at the close of entries for the 7 year old championships.

- The rider is the rider competing the horse at the start of the 7 year old championships.

- In the event of two eligible horses finishing in the first three of the seven year old Championships, the highest placed horse will win the Grand Slam.

- In the event of an objection to the results, the final decision will be made by the Council of SHB(GB) .
