SHB(GB) Equine Influenza Vaccinations Policy

- a. Any horse receiving a new Primary Course of equine influenza vaccine as of 1st January 2026 must be vaccinated as follows;
- ❖ 1st vaccination - 2nd vaccination interval 21-60 days. Horses having received first two vaccinations may compete, providing 2nd vaccination has not been given within 7 days of arriving at an event.
 - ❖ 3rd vaccination to be given within 120 – 180 days after 2nd, so long as 3rd vaccination has not been given within 7 days of arriving at an event.
 - ❖ All further boosters under FEI rules must be given within 6 months and 21 days to allow horses to compete.
 - ❖ The minimum standard is Horses must have been vaccinated to comply with the requirements for the Primary Course, First Booster and all subsequent boosters.
 - ❖ Horses that received their primary course before 2005 are exempt from the first booster requirement. Subsequent boosters must have been given at intervals no later than 1 calendar year after the primary course.
 - ❖ All competitors are strongly advised to check the FEI website for ongoing FEI updates before 2026. it is recommended that all competitors/exhibitors/Members/producers check with shows that fall under FEI regulation before entering, e.g. Windsor, Hickstead, HOYS, etc.
