GENERAL CONDITIONS AND REGULATIONS

The show is run in accordance with SHB(GB) 2026 Rules with the exception of Horse of the Year Show classes, which are run under Horse of the Year Show rules. In all HOYS classes, Horse of the Year Show rules take precedence, a copy of which can be downloaded from www.hoys.co.uk. Horses must be registered with either SHB(GB), BSHA or TSR and all Owners, Exhibitors and Riders must be Members of either SHB(GB), BSHA or TSR. Riders must be 15 years of age or older. **Registration numbers must be quoted on entry forms.** Classes 2-3, 44, 48 & 78-82 are qualifiers for the **Horse of the Year Show, NEC**, Birmingham, 7th – 11th October 2026. These classes entitle eligible amateur combinations to earn points for the Premier Amateur League, with the opportunity of gaining a wild card place at HOYS 2026. This is open to current TSR members or those that have signed up to the Premier Amateur League 2026, for more information see www.theshowingregister.co.uk. In classes 48, & 77–82 no horse lower than fifth will qualify. In the Championship of classes 2 & 3, no horse lower than third will qualify. Qualification will be verified by the Horse of the Year Show Office.

Horses competing at the Horse of the Year Show and qualifying shows in The Hunter sections of The Sport Horse Breeding of Great Britain classes at their Affiliated Shows cannot compete in Hack, Cobs and Riding Horse classes at the same show, on the same day and vice versa. This does not apply to SHB (GB) Ridden Sport Horse classes. Entries in these classes may not compete in the Small Show Hunter of the Year and vice versa.

Exhibitors are required by DEFRA to carry with them Official Identity Documents for all horses/ponies when competing or travelling. Competitors are reminded that it is a DEFRA requirement that the Official Identity Documents must be in the name of the legal owner within 30 days of ownership. This must be registered with the breed society, relevant studbook or ID issuing agency, dependant on breed/type of animal. Spot checks may be carried out at qualifying shows and by breed societies.

MEMBERSHIP:

Owners and riders of horses in all ridden classes must be full members of SHB(GB), unless competing on a day ticket with the exception of the Ridden Irish Draught Classes, Ridden Mare & Veteran classes, Ridden Cleveland Bay classes, Burghley Young Event Horse, Sport Horse Classes and Horse of the Year Show classes. Exhibitors in In-Hand classes have to be registered members of SHB(GB), which is free of charge.

Opening & Closing Date:

- SHB(GB) Hunter Champion Show: Entries Close on 31st July at Midnight
- Burghley Young Event Horse: Entries Open – 8th June Entries Close on 31st July at Midnight

Late Entries:

- SHB(GB) Hunter Champion Show: 1st August to 11th August at Midnight – 50% extra
On the Day - 100% extra
- Burghley Young Event Horse: No Late Entries

Acknowledgement of Entries and Allocation of Numbers:

SHB(GB) Hunter Champion Show:

Numbers will be available for collection from the Secretary's Office at the show between 4pm & 6pm on Tuesday 11th August; between 7am & 5pm on Wednesday 12th August and between 7am & 1pm on Thursday 13th August.

Burghley Young Event Horse:

Start times will be available on Eventing Scores (www.eventingscores.co.uk) after 10:00am on Friday 7th August.

COMPETITORS TO PROVIDE THEIR OWN NUMBERS/NUMBER BIB.

There Will Not be an Exhibitors' Mailout Prior to the Show.

SAFETY / INSURANCE:

The Organisers of this Show have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organisers and all the Officials and Stewards.

OBJECTIONS:

Objections of any kind must be made in writing, and delivered to the Secretary, within one hour of the close of the judging of the class concerned, accompanied by a deposit of Two Hundred & Fifty Pounds, which deposit will be forfeited if the objection should prove to be frivolous. The Objector must also state the particular and precise character of his objection. All objections will be referred to the Council, whose decision will be final.

JMB HEIGHT CERTIFICATION:

Animals in ridden height restricted classes WILL NOT be required to be in possession of a JMB Height Certificate or verification of measurement to compete in RIHS or HOYS Qualifiers. However qualifying animals will need to be measured WITHIN 28 DAYS OF QUALIFICATION OR BEFORE THE FINAL, WHICHEVER IS SOONER. The valid JMB full height certificate or a valid JMB annual height certificate must be submitted to the SHB(GB) office on receipt from the JMB and prior to competing at RIHS or HOYS. There are NO exceptions to this rule.

PRIZES:

In unsponsored ridden classes, prize money may be reduced on the following sliding scale: 3 entries - money to 1st Place only; 5 entries - money to 2nd Place only; 6 entries - money to 3rd Place only; 9 entries - money to 4th Place.

BROOD MARE PREMIUMS:

Brood Mare Premiums will be awarded in classes 7, 17, 21, 23, 25, 35 & 46. Premiums will only be awarded if there are a minimum of three mares forward. The premium takes the form of a rosette and Service Voucher to the value of £100, awarded at the Judge's discretion to their selection from the monetary prize winners, to be used in either of the two years following the year of that award. The owner must be, or become, a fully paid-up member of the SHB(GB) in order to be eligible for the award. No mare shall take more than one award per year.

PROGENY OF GRADED MARES:

In classes 8-11, 13-14, 19-20, 22, 24, 26-34, 36-39 incl. a rosette will be awarded to the highest placed exhibit out of a SHB(GB) graded mare.

THOROUGHBRED SPECIAL AWARD:

In classes 7-11, 17-32, 35-38 incl. a rosette will be awarded to the highest placed exhibit with a minimum of 50% Thoroughbred breeding, kindly sponsored by Culworth Grounds.

CLASSES:

The Society reserves the right to amalgamate classes in the event of insufficient entries.

Every effort will be made for classes not to clash, but once a class has started a horse cannot leave the ring to compete in another class and then return to the original class.

All entries, except foals, must be in possession of current Influenza Vaccination Certificate and such document, which must undeniably relate to the horse in question, must accompany the animal when brought to the Show and may be examined.

All entries must be registered with SHB(GB), Passported or Over-stamped before the entry is accepted unless competing on a day ticket or in a Horse of the Year Show Qualifier or in a class where it is specified that registration is not required - see conditions as printed on Day Ticket application form which is available to download from www.sporthorsegb.co.uk.

Entries in the Ridden Sport Horse classes, In-Hand Irish Draught classes, Ridden Irish Draught classes, Ridden Mare class, In-Hand Cleveland Bay classes, Ridden Cleveland Bay classes and Veteran classes do not have to be registered with SHB(GB) and exhibitors do not have to be members of SHB(GB), but if competing in any other classes at the show a Day Ticket must be purchased. Foals at foot do not have to be registered in their own right. Exhibits in In-Hand classes do not have to be registered or over-stamped.

CHAMPIONSHIPS:

All horses eligible for Championships must be forward.

FIRST AID:

A first aid fee of £6 per rider or In-Hand exhibitor is payable at time of entry.

STABLES AND HOOK UP:

Stables and Hook up are **to be booked directly with Addington Equestrian**. Please go to their website www.addington.co.uk

NO STABLE BOOKINGS OR BOOKINGS FOR HOOK UP WILL BE ACCEPTED BY ADDINGTON EQUESTRIAN AFTER 7th August 2026

FARRIER:

A farrier will be on call – details will be publicised at the show and available from the Stable Manager's Office.

TROPHIES:

Trophies may be presented in the ring at the time of prize giving BUT will not be available for collection to take home.

General Data Protection Regulation

Please note that there will be a photographer on site and photographs taken may be used on the SHB(GB) website, Facebook page and may be issued to Third Party Publications for the purpose of publicising the show, results and general PR in relation to SHB(GB). In addition, class sponsors may receive pictures of awards to prize winners. If you do not want any pictures that may be taken of you/your horse utilised in this way, please make the Secretary's office at the show aware.

Sport Horse Breeding (GB) Equine Influenza Vaccinations Policy

Any horse receiving a new Primary Course of equine influenza vaccine as of 1st January in the current year must be vaccinated as follows: 1st vaccination -2nd vaccination interval 21-60 days. Horses having received the first two vaccinations may compete, providing 2nd vaccination has not been given within 7 days of arriving at the event. 3rd vaccination to be given within 120 – 180 days after the 2nd, so long as the 3rd vaccination has not been given within 7 days of arriving at the event. All further boosters under FEI rules must be given within 6 months and 21 days to allow horses to compete.

The minimum standard is Horses must have been vaccinated to comply with the requirements for the Primary Course, First Booster and all subsequent boosters.

Horses that received their primary course before 2005 are exempt from the first booster requirement. Subsequent boosters must have been given at intervals no later than 1 calendar year after the primary course.

All competitors are strongly advised to check the FEI website for ongoing FEI updates. It is recommended that all competitors/exhibitors/members/producers check with shows that fall under FEI regulation before entering, e.g. Windsor, Hickstead, HOYS, etc.

This Rule may be subject to change from guidance from the FEI/BEF and any changes will be notified via the Sport Horse Breeding (GB) website. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR THE BRITISH HORSE FEEDS/IRISH DRAUGHT CLASSES:

This show is affiliated to the Irish Draught Horse Society (GB) and as such all exhibits entering into classes 12, 13, 62, & 63 must be eligible under the below criteria.

GENERAL ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA: Important please read:

ALL horses must be registered with or overstamped by the IDHS (GB) and in the correct ownership. Owners of Pure-bred Irish Draughts and Irish Draught Sport Horses/Part bred) must be **FULL** members of the IDHS (GB) to compete.

Irish Draught Sport Horses/Part bred are horses that have a minimum of 25% proven Irish Draught breeding.

In-Hand Breeding Classes: mares with foals at foot, 3 years and over must be inspected and classified as Class 1 (or RID), Class 2 or Supplementary Grade Up (or AID) Pure-bred ID and ID Sport Horses / Part bred.

Pure-Bred Youngstock: must be the progeny of an inspected Mare (Class 1, Class 2, RID (GB), AID or Supplementary Grade Up Register) and be by a Class 1, 2 or RID (GB) stallion on the Irish Draught Breed Register.

3 year old colts must be un-inspected All 1, 2 & 3 year old colts must be bitted and shown by experienced handlers over 18 years of age.

All Pure-Bred Irish Draught Stallions, including ridden must be inspected and overstamped by the IDHS (GB) and be Class 1, 2 or RID (GB). Stallions must display a red, white and blue ribbon in their tails and be shown by experienced rider/handler over 18 years of age.

Ridden Horses must be 153cms (15hh) or over.

This show is a qualifier for the £2,000 Ridden Challenge jointly sponsored by the IDHS (GB) and Yorkshire Irish Draught & Hunter Show. The highest placed Pure Bred and Part Bred (not already qualified) from classes 57-61, 64-67 and 78-81 will qualify for the final.

To qualify, classes 57-61, 64-67 and 78-81 must follow the same eligibility criteria as for both the Irish Draught & Irish Draught Sport Horse (Part Bred) classes but need not be registered with/over stamped by the IDHS(GB) to qualify however, must be on the appropriate Register or over stamped by the IDHS(GB) and the owner be a full member of the Society by the time of the Championship. For the purposes of determining that a Horse is a Thoroughbred: if the Horse was foaled in Great Britain, Ireland or the Channel Islands, it must be registered in the register of the breeding of thoroughbred horses maintained by the Stud Book Authority of Great Britain and Ireland (known as “Weatherby’s General Stud Book”); and if the Horse is foaled in a country other than Great Britain, Ireland or the Channel Islands, the Entrant must be able to produce a certificate from the Horse’s country of origin which demonstrates that the Horse is a Thorough bred.

The following Horses are not eligible to be exhibited at the Competition:

- any stallion or entire;
- any Horse that has been placed 1st in any previous Racehorse to Riding Horse Show Championship at Horse of the Year Show (“HOYS”);
- any Horse that has not run in any race (including point to point, national hunt or on the flat) under the rules of a Recognised Racing Authority;
- any Horse under 148cm tall;
- any Horse under 4 years old; or
- any Horse that is not a Thoroughbred

The first horse will go forward to Horse of the Year Show; if the first horse has already qualified, at the organiser’s discretion, horses down the line will be eligible to compete at the HOYS Championship.

Racehorse to Riding Horse Horses must be over 4 years old and 148cms or over, riders must be 15 years old and over.

Riders must wear hard hats fitted with a safety harness (to an approved and accepted standard) and correct footwear with a heel while mounted in the ring.

Simple snaffle bridles must be worn as per rules for British Eventing. Horses will come into the ring individually and give a short, ridden display of walk, trot & canter of approximately 1 minute then proceed straight into the jumping phase. Unless eliminated all horses will return without saddles for conformation assessment.
